Rotational Experiences	Notes
General Surgery	All general surgery rotations include many of the essential content areas such as the abdomen and its contents; the alimentary tract; non-cardiac thoracic surgery; skin, soft tissues, and breast; endocrine surgery; and head and neck surgery.
Dedicated Rotations	Dedicated rotations are provided in pediatric surgery; surgical oncology; trauma and surgical critical care; acute care surgery; vascular; endoscopy; transplant hepato-pancreato-biliary surgery; colorectal surgery; bariatric and minimally invasive surgery; non-cardiac thoracic surgery; cardiac surgery; orthopaedic surgery; burn surgery; and ear, nose and throat surgery.
Elective Options	Residents will have multiple elective options, including trauma, critical care, vascular surgery, surgical oncology, urologic surgery and general surgery.
Vacation	Residents will not be allowed to take vacation during rotations in night float, burns, transplant or pediatric surgery.
